

Nice Hôtel Historique

More than a stay, an experience!



The Nice Côte d'Azur Metropolitan Convention & Visitors Bureau develops promotional tools to promote Nice's UNESCO World Heritage status as "Nice, the Winter Resort Town of the Riviera".

The "Nice Hôtel Historique" label reinforces this scheme. It **identifies accommodation facilities already in existence** at that time, from 1760 to 1940, which are still in operation and still bear witness to the aestheticism of the time.

For visitors from all over the world, it offers an experience in the spirit of the Riviera winter resort.

The creation of the "Nice Hôtel Historique" label

Based on a list of criteria set out in an evaluation grid, a committee of experts examines the applications and awards the label.

Evaluation visits were carried out to determine whether or not to award the label.

The Nice Hôtel Historique (NHH) label is awarded to establishments where the owner has demonstrated a genuine desire to preserve the hotel's historic character.

> NHH 2025 Label awarded in 3 categories
15 establishments competed **for 9 awards**.

- **NHH BRONZE** identifies hotels whose façade and general atmosphere reflect the spirit of the Riviera winter resort;

Best Western Plus Hôtel Masséna,
Hôtel Le Grimaldi by HappyCulture,
Hôtel Petit Palais.

- **NHH SILVER** recognizes, in addition, the historical coherence of the hotel's common areas:

Boscolo Nice hotel & Spa,
Westminster Hôtel & Spa Nice,
Hôtel Vendôme Nice.

- **NHH GOLD** is awarded to establishments that have, as a whole, maintained their historical coherence.

Le Negresco,
Hôtel Gounod Nice,
Hôtel Villa Rivoli.

The various types of accommodation of the period are well represented, with a balanced mix of Palaces, Hotels in character buildings and Guesthouses.

These establishments can be identified by a plaque bearing the above logo.
